### IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

### **Equipment Applications**

### **Equipment Testing**

Range tests should be carried out at least once a week, more often when critical criteria apply. They should involve testing the unit past the limit of its required working range so as to ensure a measure of safety. Inter Page suggests that a log should be kept of all the test dates and the information gathered, together with the service records.

The frequency of the tests required will vary between applications. If a pager has been dropped or is worn by a person involved in an accident, the unit should be tested again before re-use. It must be stressed that the physical range tests are essential and any construction work or movement of plant or equipment, could alter the signaling capability of the unit.



### **Package Components:**

- 1. Silent Page Alpha paging transmitter
- 2. Power Adapter (8.4 VDC, 1.3 Amp regulated)
- 3. Quarter wave whip antenna (with right angled BNC adapter)
- 4. Operational Manual





- 1. Connect the power supply cord to the **Silent Page** desktop paging system and plug power supply into an AC outlet.
- 2. Connect antenna to the back of the transmitter.
- 3. Connect keyboard to the back of the transmitter.
- 4. To alert a pager enter the desired pager number on the keyboard of the **Silent Page** transmitter and press **Enter**.
- 5. The screen will now display ENTER MESSAGE:

6. If you have alphanumeric pagers with your system enter alphanumeric message desired and press enter.

# PREPROGRAMMED MESSAGES:

- 1. To add/change your preprogrammed messages, press escape once. When prompted enter password 1234 and press enter. From the main menu, arrow down to option 7 (Edit PPG Message) and press enter/send. PPG message: 01 will appear. Press enter/send to enter edit mode. Use the delete key to remove the default message before entering your new custom message. Once you enter the desired message press enter/send to exit the edit message mode. To change the other messages press the Up or Down arrow and select the message to edit.
- 2. Once all changes are made keep pressing the escape button until the transmitter saves and resets to paging mode.
- 3. Caution: Do not make any other changes that may affect the Transmitter operation.

- 4. To send a preprogrammed message: Enter the pager number and press enter/send. Press the Down Arrow once and *preprogrammed message* # will appear. Enter the preprogrammed message number using a two digit format. Press send after the preprogrammed message appears. Example: Enter pager #01 downarrow and #01 (Go to Rm #1) press send.
- 5. To set time and date, press escape once. Enter 1234 as password. Press 2 to enter time and date. Press 0 to change to AM. Press 1 to change to PM.

#01 Go to Rm #1

#02 Go to Rm #2

#03 Go to Rm #3

# \*NOTE: THE WIRE COLORS ARE BASED UPON ON USING A STANDARD RJ45 (NETWORK) CABLE. THIS CABLE IS NOT PROVIDED WITH THE SILENT PAGE ALPHA.

To program the contacts follow the instructions below.

- 1. Press the escape key on the keyboard.
- 2. Enter "1234" as the password.
- 3. Use the down arrow key to scroll to #5 (Edit Alarm Message) and press enter.
- 4. "Alarm Message: 1" will appear on the screen. Press enter. "Input Page To" will appear and it will be highlighted.
- 5. Press enter to input the pager number that the alarm message will go to. (I.E. "200")
- 6. After entering the pager number press enter. The screen will now show "Input Page To" and "Input Message". Use the down arrow key to highlight "Input Message" and press enter.
- 7. Delete the default message and enter a message of your choosing. Press enter once the message is complete.
- 8. Press the escape key once. Use the up or down arrows to cycle through the other six alarms. To edit the alarms repeat steps 5 through 7.

9.	Once all alarms are programmed press the escape button until the words "Saving
	Pager Data" appear on the screen. The Silent Page Alpha will now save all of the
	information and reboot back to the normal operation mode.
